Dear brothers,

This letter is to make known our objection to your sectarianism. You have separated yourselves from the fellowship of the universal body of Christ and specifically from the fellowship of the local churches, the expression of the one body! As brothers representing all the churches in Canada, we declare that we cannot sanction your way of divisiveness.

You all have demonstrated your separation from the fellowship by rejecting the discipline by so many churches, of Joseph Fung and brothers like him, and have carelessly ignored the damage which these brothers caused to the body of Christ. As the churches in Canada, we stand in oneness with the decision of the other churches on the earth! Their stand is our stand!

In Vancouver, Richmond and Scarborough, you brothers have separated yourselves and established separate factions, each with a so-called Lord's table. You have left the ground of oneness! In Vancouver and Richmond, although you and your tables should display the fellowship of both the body and the blood of the Lord (1 Corinthians 10:14-17), you have in actuality shown contempt for this fellowship! In Scarborough, both the table of the meeting of Bill Chiu and other brothers from Hong Kong under the influence of Joseph Fung; and the table of the meeting of who is also in close fellowship with Joseph Fung, are representative of the confusion among you regarding the stand of the church in a locality. Are such meetings and tables the testimony of Jesus Christ? No! They rather demonstrate a lack of self-control, the work of men doing what is right in their own eyes, and they further Christendom's divisiveness to our Lord's body!

All the churches in Canada, standing in one accord cannot agree with your rebellion to the Lord and His one body. To those innocent sheep among you, who have been misled into this confusion, we pray that you would see the evil source behind these divisions. We exhort you to listen and follow the voice of the Lord Who is calling you to return to the truth regarding the proper standing for His testimony!
